She will be supported by additional Camper Care Specialists and will work closely with our unit heads, counselors, and the rest of our staff to ensure that each and every camper's needs are met.

In all cases, Camper Care staff or professional staff will provide a direct and full response as soon as possible. If the concern is simple and can be answered by our office staff, they will do so. Our Camper Care staff will also be in regular communication with our leadership team including unit heads and department heads, who will always be part of decision-making and consultation with our campers and parents, as needed, throughout the summer.
