

HSJ Counselor Typical Day	Your Responsibilities
7:45AM Wake up	Get your campers out of bed, teeth-brushed, and dressed for breakfast. Make sure they have what they need for their morning activities
8:15AM Breakfast	Enjoy breakfast with your cabin after lining up in the Breezeway for Hamotzi
8:55AM Reetz Ratz	Listen to all-camp announcements and play fun games while specialists set-up activities
9:10AM First Hour	Lead your assigned activity, unless it's your hour off
10:10AM Second Hour	Lead your assigned activity, unless it's your hour off
11:10AM Third Hour	Lead your assigned activity, unless it's your hour off
12:10PM Nikayon	Head back to your cabin and supervise your campers as they clean. Everyone has an assigned job that rotates. You must help as needed, make your bed, and ensure that your area is tidy
12:45PM Lunch	Enjoy lunch with your cabin after lining up in the Breezeway for Hamotzi
1:45PM Rest Hour	If you're "Rest Hour OD" (on duty) then you must be in your cabin. Otherwise, you have this period off
3:00PM Canteen	Bring your cabin to the Breezeway for a mid-day snack before afternoon activities
3:15PM Fourth Hour	Lead your assigned activity, unless it's your hour off
4:15PM Fifth Hour	Lead your assigned activity, unless it's your hour off
5:15PM Prep for Dinner	Return to your cabin and help get campers ready for dinner and evening programs
6:15PM Dinner	Enjoy dinner with your cabin after lining up in the Breezeway for Hamotzi
7:00PM Chofesh	If you're in charge of the night's evening program, use this time to set up your area with supplies. Otherwise, supervise campers as they enjoy free time outside
7:30PM Evening Program	Attend, participate, and supervise. Evening programs are prepared by counselors for each unit and are different every night
Lights Out	Get campers ready for bed, have cabin prayers, and submit your cabin log. If you're "Nighttime OD" (on duty) then you must stay in your cabin for the night. Otherwise, you can enjoy free time afterwards
1:00AM Curfew	All staff must return to their cabins and go to bed

*****This schedule is a "typical" camp day. Fridays and Saturdays will follow a slightly altered schedule. Certain special event days, like Opening Day, Closing Day, and Maccabiah, will also follow different schedules.**

On any given day, you will have either one or two activity periods off, but your hours off may be different from one day to the next.

Each cabin will have at least two counselors. Each day, one counselor will be "Rest Hour OD" which means they will cover the cabin at rest hour.

Lights Out time is different for each unit. Each night, one counselor or out-of-cabin staff member will be "Nighttime OD" which means they will stay in the cabin that night. If your Nighttime OD is someone other than the counselors in your cabin, you must wait until they arrive to leave the cabin.
